Note1:

It's allowed that graduates could choose 8 or 6 credits (8 credits for Master degree and 6 credits for Doctoral degree) of outside institute elective courses. But for international students, there is no credit limit. Just fill in the table (The Consent of Outside Institute Elective Credits for international Students) and then sign by your advisor and director. Do keep this consent until you apply for degree examination.

Note2:

- a. The compulsory course "Seminar" is divided to seminar (1), seminar (2), seminar (3), seminar (4). When you apply for degree examination, we will audit whether you had accomplished these four different seminars. So remember to check your course list or transcript each semester. If you find any mistake, please contact the staff in Department Office as soon as possible.
- **b.** For international students, no matter which seminar you choose, just join the **seminar group special for international students** when you come to seminar course.
